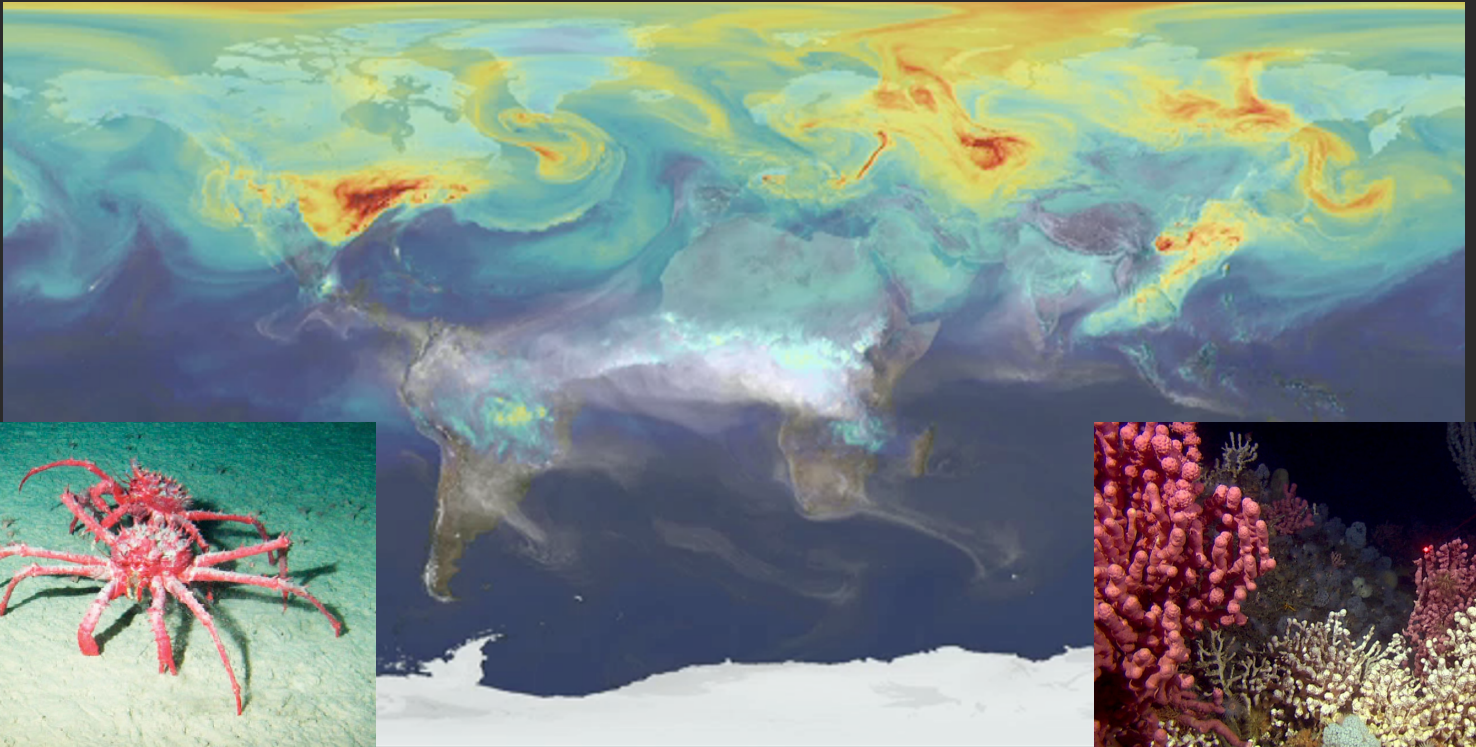


CLIMATE CHANGE IN THE DEEP OCEAN: *Why does it matter?*
